

2019 ISRP: Applying for the J-1 Visa Guide

March 15, 2019: Visa request forms due

- DS-2019 Request Form
- Copy of biographical page of passport (*passport must be valid up to six months after date of entry into USA*)
- Evidence of financial support (*a bank statement showing liquid funds no older than three months from the date of submission*)
- <u>Evidence of Health Insurance Form</u> (To meet the J-1 insurance coverage requirements students will either purchase or waive an existing insurance plan through Garnett-Powers & Associates)

Mid-April: Secure your visa appointment at your local U.S. embassy or consulate

- Locate your nearest U.S. embassy or consulate here: <u>https://www.usembassy.gov/</u>
- Visa wait times are located here: <u>https://travel.state.gov/content/travel/en/us-visas/visa-information-resources/wait-times.html</u>
- Go to the "Visas" → "Non-immigrant Visas" and follow the instructions for booking your appointment
 - You will need your **SEVIS number** located on your Form DS-2019 to book your appointment.
 - You will also need UC San Diego's Program Number. This number is **P-1-02849**.
 - You must pay the <u>I-901 SEVIS Fee</u> in preparation for your interview. This is \$180 for J-1 exchange visitors must be paid 3 business days before applying for the visa.
- Prepare for your interview by reading the "<u>10 Tips for Your Visa Interview</u>"

Hay 31, 2019: Earliest date students may enter the U.S. on their J-1 visa

- Carry your DS-2019 as well as your passport and visa in your <u>hand luggage</u>. You are required to show this to the Customs & Border Protection officials at your port of entry.
- Your passport will be scanned, and you will be able to retrieve a copy of your entry record, or <u>I-94 record</u>, online within 24-48 hours.

June 30, 2019: ISRP Begins

- Attend orientation on <u>July 1, 2019</u> and have your visa and I-94 record with you to be checked by International Center staff.
- Must have satisfied insurance coverage requirement by purchasing or waiving with an existing insurance plan through Garnett-Powers & Associates by the start date of the program.
